Adding to composts

Add 30 percent extra Horticultural Grit Sand (by volume) to compost to create the best open and free draining potting material for plants. Mix well. This helps to prevent waterlogging and recreates the plant's natural habitat. Re-pot pot-bound plants in spring, into a slightly larger pot.

Improving heavy soils

Add to small areas of clay soil to improve drainage and aeration. Use Horticultural Grit Sand in channels leaving a path open for water, (don't work it in). Avoid working clay soils too much as they will become sticky and compact.



Other useful tips

1. A great planting mix for alpine or rock gardens is one part loam to one part Horticultural Grit Sand and one part leaf mould or coir.
2. Tease out the roots of the plant slightly and remove any weeds from the surface compost. Make sure the plants are planted firmly in the compost mix. Top-dress with Horticultural Gravel or Grit.
